Rajesh Kumar, born K.R. Rajagopal on March 20, 1947, in Coimbatore, is a prominent Tamil author known for his prolific contributions to crime fiction. He began his writing career in the late 1960s, with his first short story published in 1968. His first novel. Vaadagaiku Oru Uyir, was released in 1980, marking the start of a remarkable journey where he would go on to write over 1.500 novels and more than 2.000 short stories

Kumar's writing is characterized by engaging plots and has garnered him a dedicated readership not just in Tamil Nadu but also among the Tamil diaspora worldwide. His works often explore themes of crime and detective fiction. earning him the title of the "king of crime thrillers" in Tamil literature. In recognition of his contributions, he received the prestigious Kalaimaamani award from the Tamil Nadu government in 2010






